The most convenient method of annual payment of donations to the Anne Carpmael Charitable Trust is by standing order. Please complete and sign the attached form and return it to The Anne Carpmael Trust at the address above. We will forward it to your bank. Alternatively cheques may be sent, made payable to 'The Anne Carpmael Trust'.

Additionally, UK taxpayers can increase the value of donations to The Anne Carpmael Trust through Gift Aid, without incurring any extra cost to themselves. By signing the declaration at the bottom of the attached form, the Trust can recoup income tax from the Inland Revenue on gifts of any amount donated. If you choose to give in this way, please ensure that you tick the box at the bottom.

How Gift Aid works-

Charities take your donation, which is money you have already paid tax on – and then reclaim the basic tax (at 20 per cent) on its 'gross' equivalent (the amount before tax was deducted). In practice, this means that if you give £10 to charity using Gift Aid, that gift is worth £12.50 to the charity. This is because the charity claims back the basic rate tax on your donation directly from HM Revenue and Customs.

Between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011 the charity will also get Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give. The 'transition relief' for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.

Higher rate taxpayers can claim further tax relief through their tax returns.

The Gift Aid scheme is only for gifts of money by UK taxpayer and there are rules limiting the value of benefits, which can be received in return.
